 - If a request meets all the requirements and the money is not going to the organization, it could still be accepted and funded.
 - There are some events that we usually help with. We could add these events into something other than the funding request because they do enhance culture.
 - Have these requests that are going to charity become more lengthy processes such as providing a presentation or further details.

- We would need to okay the ones that organizations consider their fundraisers and senate would have to approve the list.
- If it is an orgs fundraiser but decide not to do it one year, then another organization should be able to pick it up and do it instead. Thought that the senate can approve the list every year, and when an org decides to drop something then another org can proceed with that fundraiser.
- When sending in your list, just be as inclusive as possible for the beginning of this so we can figure out how to determine big ticket vs. small ticket items.
