## **Grant Committee Meeting #1**

## 9/20/16

- 1. Background
  - a. Student Success and Support Fund was started to help promote alumni funding of events,
    - i. Previously have helped purchase white coat and small travel stipends, we now have \$4000 to work with
- 2. How much per student?
  - a. Must take into account how many students are interested in going
  - b. \$250 may not cover enough expenses for students, although would be able to provide for 16 students
  - c. \$400 could send 10 people
- 3. What conferences will be included?
  - a. Students could check off which conference they want to attend
  - b. Same amount for each conference, as travel costs will be about the same for each
  - c. Conferences this grant money will extend to are: ACCP, ASHP Midyear, and APhA
    - i. APhA and ASHP will each receive four grants
    - ii. ACCP will receive two
- 4. How do we give the money out?
  - a. Could eliminate grad students (those who want to attend will typically receive funding from their labs) and Pharmtox students (decreased interest)
  - b. Decided against eliminating 1<sup>st</sup> years from the pool
  - c. Stipulation that if you receive the grant, you must report back what you have learned
  - d. There will be retroactive compensation (need some sort of accountability) with proof of attendance in the form of receipts
  - e. Students must promote photos from event
  - f. All pharmacy students may participate
  - g. An application will be involved that contains two questions, and if the application meets the criteria the applicants will be put in a lottery system and randomly selected
    - i. Each response must be around 200 words
    - ii. The two questions will be:
      - 1. Why do you want to attend this conference?
      - 2. What do you plan on attending/what sessions are you interested in at the conference?
  - h. Students must provide a link to conference information, proof of registration may come after the raffle
  - i. Only one application per student per year
- 5. Logistics
  - a. Review process via the Student Senate Task Force
  - b. Students who turn in an incomplete application will be notified of their disqualification
  - c. Application will be available online through Moodle in the PDE
  - d. Deadline for ASHP will be mid-November (11/18)

- e. Can look into dates for APhA later on when more information about the conference is posted
- f. Open the ACCP application asap, as the decided deadline 10/08
  - i. Provides two weeks to review
- g. Announcements via the student org email, class reps in class, or as part of their weekly emails
