22. Student orgs have different responsibilities than SIGs do, has the Senate oversight
23. Do not want to set hard lines between the two
24. Three years was chosen as probationary period so an entirely new group of students will take over the group
ii. SIGs were started as a way to gauge interest for them and to conserve funding, but wanted a mechanism for students to band together that was easier than starting a new student organization
25. SIGs also have less pressure and more time to figure out strengthening the group
iii. SIGs are experiencing fundraising issues
26. Cannot collect dues, fundraise within the school, or reach out to pharmacy students about community fundraisers
