
## **CHOICE OF THESIS LABORATORY FORM**

## **UW-Madison Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences**



New Pharm Sci students should identify a thesis advisor/permanent laboratory by the end of their first fall semester. The laboratory rotation process is intended to help new graduate students explore research and advisors of interest. The program suggests that students keep an open mind as they move through rotations and not approach faculty about permanent placement until all rotations are complete. Of course, the ultimate choice of a permanent advisor/lab is a mutual one, and sometimes a student's first (or second) choice cannot be satisfied, for various reasons.

Once an agreement is made, both you and your professor will need to fill in the information below and upload it to the <u>Choice of Lab Box Folder</u>. Please note that you must identify a lab that ensures your support can continue after your first year.

If you are having trouble choosing or securing a lab, please contact Lara Collier for assistance. After you secure your permanent lab, you should enroll in Pharmaceutical Sciences 990 (research credits) under this faculty member for the upcoming Spring semester, and all semesters beyond
