The following requirements come from the Social and Administrative Sciences Division, as approved:

- Each preliminary exam/dissertation committee must have at least four members (committee chair + 3).
- Two committee members must be internal (i.e. graduate faculty from the SAS division Program), including the student's Dissertation Advisor.
- At least 1 Committee member must be external. The fourth member must be UW-Madison graduate faculty from outside
- Optional additional members may be selected. These additional members may be tenured or tenured-track UW-Madison faculty from a department without a graduate program; UW-Madison academic staff (or UW-Madison emeritus faculty); faculty from other institutions; other individuals deemed qualified.
- At least three members of this committee are considered "readers"—readers are committee members who commit
 themselves to closely reviewing and reading the whole dissertation
